International Epilepsy Day is an annual event organized by the International Bureau for Epilepsy (IBE) and the International League Against Epilepsy (ILAE) to raise awareness about epilepsy and its impact on individuals, families and communities around the world.

2024 Theme: #MyEpilepsy Journey

The theme of International Epilepsy Day this year – the epilepsy journey – was chosen to spotlight the lived experience of people with epilepsy and those who care for them, aiming to align with and highlight the importance of the <u>Intersectoral Global</u> <u>Action Plan on Epilepsy and other Neurological</u> <u>Disorders</u> (IGAP).

This plan, developed by the World Health Organization and unanimously approved by its member states, aims to improve access to treatment, care and quality of life of people with epilepsy, their carers, and families.

The lived experience of our community highlights challenges in areas such as access to education and employment, experiences of stigma, discrimination and social exclusion, impact on mental health and wellbeing, burden on informal carers and families, difficulties in personal relationships, inability to access insurance, to drive a car, or to be an active part of the society.






#50MillionSteps




